

PLANNING APPLICATION 0/49367 CAMPING PODS IN THE FORMAL GARDENS OF KINMEL HALL

At the end of last month we received an email from our contact with the Marquess of Anglesey which read: -

Dear Paul

Thank you for your email and the planning application withdrawal notification.

I think it will be very hard to encourage the Council to enforce the removal of Mr Cryer's pods.

As far as I am concerned Mr Cryer cannot run a business without the necessary planning permissions and licences. Therefore, I do not feel he can trade other than is a way which is non-compliant with the law.

I feel the best approach is to do all that can be done to stop him trading without planning permissions etc.,

My inclination is that a letter should be sent to the Council Planning Team seeking clarification as to whether or not Mr Cryer can trade without and, if not, ask what measures will be taken by the Council to ensure that he does not trade until such time as the planning application has been received and approved (if it ever is). I hope this reply is of some help. It may not be as positive as you would like but I feel it best to put the ball fully in the Council's court.

This email was forwarded to one of the Senedd Members for North Wales with the request that they approach the Council in their own person to find out what – if anything – they intended doing now the Planning Application had been withdrawn by the owner of the Hall.

An email was subsequently sent to Paula Jones asking these questions and the response was forwarded to us.

In the response, Paula Jones stated that a recent visit to the site had been made and that: -

'no evidence of any business activity to warrant a material change of use was identified.'

If we do become aware of such activity then an investigation would be required to examine the extent of business activity to see if a material change of use has occurred and then an expediency decision would need to be made on whether to take formal enforcement action.'

After, some more emails between the Senedd member and ourselves where evidence was presented to the Minister not only of the illegal use of the pods but also other actions of the owner of the Hall.

The responses we received just made the situation more complicated because the Senedd Member was taking as gospel the information provided by Conwy Council and because their knowledge of the location is not known they tried separating photographic evidence supplied by the tenants of Hamilton House as part of their objections to the Planning Application from the document and stated that: -

'the only photos I can see at the end of Pauline Watkins' e-mail show an outdoor fire, knee and bottle; and a moldy wall.'

And: -

Unless I am missing something, these photos neither show pods nor indicate where or when they were taken

The problem with this last statement was the fact that the photo of the 'moldy wall' was accompanied by text which read: -

CHRIS CRYER 20 OCT 2021

'Let's see who really cares

With winter kicking in.....'

If that did not confirm where the photos came from because they were on the Facebook page for the Hall.

In the last email received the evidence provided was again ignored and referred to the email from Paula

Jones as the reason why there was nothing he could do without

'evidence of any business use being carried out at the Hall at the moment, or "until such time as the planning application has been received and approved (if it ever is)'

The problem with this response is the fact that the information provided by Paula is fine – so far as it goes.

However, unless you know the Hall and know the route taken by the officers of the Council carrying out the 'site visit' – which did not include Paula Jones.

During a conversation with the Conservation Officer of the Council. The route taken to and from the roof was confirmed as follows: -

> Enter via the Main Doors on the East Front



➤ Take the stairs from the Sunken Lounge to the Main Corridor

> Take Main Staircase up to First Floor Landing



> Turn Left along First Floor Landing



> Take Staircase to Second Floor



➤ Take Staircase to Third Floor and use one of the Fire Escapes onto the Roof



The route taken on leaving the Roof was the reverse of this.

There are several problems with this information, which anyone who knows the Hall have probably worked out for themselves!


To be able to see the Pods you would need to stand on the edge at the far end of this roof: -



This information was provided to the Senedd Member but again was not taken on board.

The other gaping hole in the information confirmed by the Council is the route taken to and from the Roof!

Those of you familiar with the layout of the Hall will know that this is only one of numerous possible routes to and from the roof. These other routes would give the visitor a greater view of other areas of the Hall, none of which have ever been taken by the two Council Officers who have carried out the 'inspections' of this building since June 2021. Prior to that the last visit to the Hall was on the 24th July 2018 and was carried out by Huw Davies as this extract of his letter to the Polish workers proves: -



The second problem with the email from Planning is the fact that the author has not been inside the Hall for several years and so she is relying on the information provided by her Enforcement Officer who has openly admitted his 'reluctance' to issue previous owners with the Urgent Works Notices warranted as a result of the deterioration damage to the Hall who also has admitted his ignorance to relevant legislation relating to the site because

'it's not data we produce or hold'

Therefore, the statement that: -

'no evidence of any business activity to warrant a material change of use was identified.'

cannot be taken as factually correct because the Hall has not been the subject of a Full Multi-disciplinary Inspection since 2013 or a Full Conservation and Enforcement Inspection since the 25th July 2018!

Both Planning and Conservation were made aware of the deplorable state of the Hall in a Teams meeting with members of The Friends of Kinmel Hall at the beginning of this year including the fact that visitors to the Pre-Auction 'tours' were also restricted as to what areas of the Hall they could see – because the remainder of the site was 'so unsafe'. One visitor to the Hall during these tours ventured up the first flight of stairs from the First Floor landing to the second floor shown earlier - which resulted in the auctioneers representative nearly having a heart attack!

In defence of the Conservation Officer – his access to the Hall is currently subject to the management structure within the Council – his Line Manager controls what he is allowed to see on the visits rather than the owner of the Hall. Hopefully this will change sooner rather than later – for the sake of the Hall!

Unfortunately, the Senedd Member does not know the Hall as well as some of us and may not be aware of the out of date knowledge of the officers of the Council with responsibility for protecting the County's Heritage.

He kept referring to a phrase from the Council's response: - 'at the moment'.

The problem is that the visit to the Hall was a planned visit – which is all this part of the Council can do – and that from where the officers of the Council were standing on the roof did not give sight of the pods.

In addition to which – and this was not explained to us by the Minister – because the application has been withdrawn all the online evidence on the Facebook page cannot be used because it pre-dates the Planning Application – unless FRESH evidence is provided.

Why the evidence provided by the tenant of Hamilton House which clearly shows how close the pods are to her property was not accepted is another matter.

In the last email received some additional points were raised which are confusing to say the least: -

1. that an e-mail from Paula Jones dated 03/02/2022 includes "I write to confirm that an application for

the siting of 16 pods and compost toilet for a temporary period of 5 years has been submitted";

This is the Planning Application that has now been WITHDRAWN

2. that Paula Jones' e-mail to you dated 16/02/2022 includes "Please note that the application relates to the siting of the pods within the grounds of the Hall and we can only take into account material planning considerations that relates to that proposal.

Although the planning history of the site is material consideration, how we assess this will be dependent on its relevance to the application itself";

The Minister did not check with the Friends what was being referred to. They would have found out that the response was to the following statement made by us: -

'May I respectfully suggest that you pull up all the Listed Planning Consents issued to a Mr Edmund David Vince and/or Mrs Florrie Hughes between 1978 - 2000 in relation to all the work carried out at Kinmel Hall. I already have these but it will help you understand the situation when you receive the objections I refer to in my last email and this one.'

And that the ONLY Listed Planning Application submitted by Mr Vince and/or Mrs Florrie Hughes was to replace the Fire Escape at the North end of the Hall!

3. and that the following article, dated 05/02/22 includes "The owner of Kinmel Hall, near Abergele, had been told to apply for planning permission for pods in the grounds or face having to remove them" and "A longer term business plan to restore the mansion has also been submitted with the application but is confidential" – see:

This relates to a third party document not supplied to him by us or known to us until that email.

The Senedd Member goes onto refer to another document issued by a third party to us but which bears no relevance to the problem highlighted by Mr Davies: -

'In terms of the glamping pods, I understand that a planning application is being made or may have been made. I have encouraged the Council to take action remove them in the interim but officers are of the view that such enforcement is unnecessary and I am not able to force them to take action.

Because the Planning Application referred to is the one that has been WITHDRAWN.

Hopefully, new contacts that we have established may be able to see what the situation is before it is too late for the Hall.

WARNING

Also, we have been informed that all the objections submitted up to the point of the withdrawal of the application will NOT be carried forward should the application be re-submitted!
